SHAMEFUL DECISION OF THE US SUPREME COURT ON DAPA and EXPANDED DACA

Fort Worth, TX (June 23, 2016) .– Proyecto Inmigrante ICS, Inc. is disappointed on the decision of the US Supreme Court against the DAPA and Expanded DACA Executive orders.

"The US Supreme Court decision today falls short to our expectations to finally put a stop to the legal injunction," said Douglas Interiano, CEO of Proyecto Inmigrante ICS, Inc.

"Even though the decision left the door open to continue the fight in favor of DAPA/DACA 2 executive orders, its very disappointing that the agony of hundreds of thousands of undocumented immigrants living with the fear of deportation extends," adds Interiano.

He pointed " We still believe that the President's executive orders are within the limits of the law."

DAPA and Expanded DACA programs have been blocked since February 2015. The Federal Judge for the District Court in Brownsville, Andrew Hanen, ordered to suspend the application of the immigration programs in response to a lawsuit filed by 26 states. The ruling was upheld by the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals in New Orleans.

"Now, the best advice for the immigrant community is stay informed, the fight it's not over yet" pointed out Interiano.
