“DESPITE DE RULING OF THE 5th U.S. CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS IN NEW ORLEANS
AGAINST DAPA /DACA PROGRAMS, WE HAVEN’T LOST HOPE”

Fort Worth, TX. – Extremely dissatisfied Proyecto Inmigrante, ICS, Inc. received the decision of the United States Court of Appeals for the 5th Circuit in New Orleans that holds the block towards the Executive Orders announced by President Barack Obama in November 2014 better known as, DAPA and DACA Extended

"Although the decision is not surprising and generates a new disappointment for the immigrant community, there is still hope."
