**IT'S OFFICIAL: BARACK OBAMA'S ADMINISTRATION APPEALS TO THE US SUPREME COURT ON
DAPA/EXTENDED DACA PROGRAMS**

RENEWS THE HOPE OF THE IMMIGRANT COMMUNITY

Fort Worth, TX. - Proyecto Inmigrante ICS, Inc. applauds the decision of President Barack Obama's administration to submit an appeal to the United States Supreme Court in an effort to unblock the DAPA and DACA Extended executive orders.

"This action renews the hope of the immigrant community that has waited years for an opportunity to emerge from the shadows" said Douglas Interiano, director and founder of Proyecto Inmigrante ICS, Inc.

He added "There is full confidence that the highest court will reach the votes necessary to accept the appeal brought by the Department of Justice in relation to DAPA and DACA Extended programs."

According to the process, the Supreme Court could determine whether or not to accept the case in January or February 2016. If they decided to review the appeal the court may be issuing a ruling at the end of June of next year.
